**State of Our Black Youth Report, 2007 Edition**

Errata: We wish to point out two errors in the published report.

- Pg. 7, last paragraph, third sentence should read “Indiana's Black rates of substantiated cases of child abuse ( 3.3 Black children per 1,000 Black youths ages 0-19), neglect (14.3 per 1,000), and sexual abuse (3.4 per 1,000) were higher than U.S. rates in 2005 (2.2 per 1,000, 8.3 per 1,000 and 0.9 per 1,000, respectively).” This does not alter the remainder of the publication.
- The Percent of 9<sup>th</sup> Graders Graduating Four Years Later reported in the Education table for each city and the state was incorrect. Below is the corrected information. This does not alter the remainder of the publication.
